Introduction

St. Elizabeth's Church was established in 1992. After the church building was destroyed by fire in December 1999, the Lord miraculously gave us the present piece of prime land, on which St. Elizabeth's Phase 1 rebuilding was completed in 2003. Through the Grace of our Lord, our ministry is growing slowly but steadily. After ten years, the demand for space has outgrown what is available. After prayerful discussion and planning, and with the strong support of the Diocese, we decided to embark on our church extension project, with a two million dollar budget, to add on an additional 8000 square feet of our space.

Extension Project Progress

The fundraising campaign was kick-started by Bishop Poole on Sept. 29, 2013. Once more we have been witnessing the dedication of members of St. Elizabeth's, who continue to contribute their utmost to the extension project. We are receiving strong support from our brothers and sisters in Christ, both locally and abroad. Above all, the Diocese of Toronto has generously approved a 1 million dollar grant in support of our extension. By the time we held our Vestry on March 2, 2014, our first target of pledges of \$585,000, (that is 75% of the amount St. E needs to raise) had been reached. The Vestry resolved unanimously to move ahead with the extension.

In the ensuing months, we liaised with the Diocese and our architect, in the preparation of various plans and drawings. In early June, 2014, we submitted our application for site plan approval to the City of Mississauga. While waiting for the green light from the City of Mississauga, we will be preparing different contracts for presentation to the Diocese for final approval.

We hope to have the sod turned in the fall of 2014 and we hope to have the new extension fully functional by the fall of 2015.

Greetings from St. E's Senior Lay Pastoral Associate

Thanks be to God.

After many years of prayers and waiting, and many months of fundraising, St. Elizabeth's parishioners have responded to our Lord's blessings and callings with faith in action. At our Vestry in March, 2014, we resolved unanimously to begin our church extension project, so that we can extend our ministry to more people in our community, to enable more to hear the Gospel, to come to worship Him and to share our fellowship in Him.

Apart from the extension of physical space, the extension of our ministry depends on the further development in other areas as well. I wish to share our emphasis on the following six areas.

1. Faith Formation

We will provide different programs for our friends and parishioners in different stages of spiritual development. For example, the "Meeting with Jesus" program is designed for seekers. "Eight Lessons in Spiritual Journey" specially caters for those who want to know more to grow spiritually. 2. Fellowship Groups

Fellowship groups will be developed as our platform for pastoral care. The Fellowship Group Team will coordinate and provide training, sharing and support to the leaders of our fellowship groups, enhancing their skills in pastoral care.

3. Caring

The emphasis of our caring team are twofold: to enable our new friends to feel welcome, and to help our "old" friends experience continual care. The task of caring will not be limited to the caring team; through teachings and sharings, we will facilitate all parishioners to participate, and thus build a loving and welcoming church together.

4. Social

The social team will organize social events and activities on different occasions and festivities, so as to promote church-wide fellowship and team building. For example, we held a Father's Day barbecue, and during the summer, we will have our "Family Fun Day", which will be open to the community.

5. Worship

The liturgical worship is a tradition of the Anglican church. We will provide opportunities for parishioners to understand and to experience the worship and the meaning and significance of the liturgy. 6. Mission and Outreach

St. Elizabeth's Church emphasizes "bringing the Gospel into the community, and bringing the community into the Church". We will provide programs to meet the needs of the community. For example, in the summer, we will be holding a series of workshops on marriage and family to promote more harmonious marital and family relationships.
